Background

The district is eligible to utilize the Texas A&M University Master Purchasing Agreement #M100299IT. All items under this agreement have been competitively bid, and discount off list pricing based on the quantity of each purchase is available. This recommended action complies with Government Code, Section 791.025. The Technology and Purchasing departments have cooperatively searched for the best options for this purchase. These 265 HP computers will replace aging classroom computers and align with current district technology. The purchase of HP computers is allocated by the expenditure of state Instructional Materials Allotment (IMA) funds.

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of the College Station Independent School District approve this Instructional Materials Allotment purchase of teacher computers for A&M Consolidated High School from MicroAge, for the amount of \$192,125.00.
