- C. CONSIDERATION, DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION RELATED TO A MANAGEMENT OVERSIGHT WORKSHOP FOR CSISD FACILITIES MAINTENANCE. Jon Hall, Executive Director for Facilities, gave an overview of the CSISD Facilities Department in regard to purpose, District policies, organizational plan, budgeting, coverage and scheduling, acreage and square footage of the district, and five year rolling operational plans. A simultaneous question and answer session with the Board occurred during the presentation. The Board was very complimentary of Mr. Hall's presentation. Recommendations from the Board were to investigate changing the hiring age, develop a driver training program, adjust the requirements for work orders being considered complete, provide more

frequent lifting and handling training and consider using bond funds when possible for one-time large projects.
