

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## BACKGROUND

The general fund capital projects budget for the current year includes funding for the purchase and installation of a liquid cooled generator for the College Station ISD Administration Building. This generator will provide an alternate source of electric power for the District's main servers and communications equipment in the event of a power outage.

A Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals was advertised to the public as required by statute. The responses have been evaluated by Mr. Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing, and Mr. David Norton, Director of Operations.

The proposal that appears to provide the best value to the District was provided by Consolidated Electric in the amount of \$25,358.00

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of College Station Independent School District consider approval of the proposal from Consolidated Electric for a liquid cooled generator in the amount of \$25,358.00.
