Background

Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP) for the Paging, Intercom, Bell and Clock Communications System for Greens Prairie Elementary was mailed to five contractors and advertised and posted according to state law and local policy. Firetron, Inc., Fire Alarm Control Systems and QC TV Corporation submitted proposals. Chris Speier, Director of Technology and Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing, evaluated and scored the proposals. Firetron, Inc. received the highest score based on the evaluation criteria listed in the proposal. This purchase is allocated by the expenditure of 2009 bond funds as approved by the School Board in the Guaranteed Maximum Price for Greens Prairie Elementary school.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the school board award this Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals, for the Paging, Intercom, Bell and Clock Communications system at Greens Prairie Elementary, to Firetron, Inc. for \$54,187.66.
