




# Reading/ELA by Student Group Compared to State




# **Math by Student Group Compared to State**




# **Writing by Student Group Compared to State**


# Reading/ELA by Student Group Compared to State




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
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
# **Science by Student Group Compared to State**

#### Percentage of CSISD Students Earning Commended Performance 2008-2010






