## BACKGROUND

In preparation for the opening of College Station High School, the attached courses are being presented to the CSISD Board of Trustees for consideration. These courses were chosen with the assistance of Advisory Committees that included business/industry representation, parents, students and staff. The committees considered local, state and national labor market information, as well as, student needs and interests in making the final decisions. All of the courses are in line with the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for Career and Technology Education (CATE).

As in the past, Board approval allows the district the opportunity to offer the courses to see how many students are interested in signing-up for them; whether a course 'makes' is dependent upon such variables as student enrollment, teacher certification, and teacher availability.


The CATE courses (*attached*) were unanimously approved by the AMCHS School Improvement Planning team and the District Educational Improvement Council.
