Subject: Consider Approval of the mascot and school colors for CSHS


BACKGROUND

To begin the process of establishing a school identity, pride, and culture for College Station High School, future CSHS students participated in the process articulated below for the selection of the mascot and school colors.

- March 4 Student meeting with principal to review mascot and school colors selection process timeline.
- March 7 Students completed write-in survey regarding their suggestions for mascot and school colors selection.
- March 10 Representative group of future CSHS students (21), parents (5), and principal met to review write-in surveys and narrow the choice of mascots and color combinations to two.
- March 21 Students vote for one of two presented mascots and color combinations on final ballot.
- March 22 CSHS principal and group of students presents mascot and color combination receiving most student votes to CSISD Board of Trustees at regularly called board meeting.

RECOMMENDATION – Board Approval

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of College Station ISD approve the mascot and school colors selected by majority vote by the future students of CSHS.
