Background

The district has historical success utilizing the Department of Information Resources (DIR), a contracting agency representing the state of Texas. As a public school, the district is eligible to purchase from DIR contracted vendors and receive statewide volume discounts. The CSISD Technology and Purchasing departments have cooperatively searched for the best options for this purchase. MicroAge is an approved DIR vendor and has a historical positive vendor relationship with the district. This purchase is allocated by the expenditure of 2009 bond funds as approved by the School Board in the Guaranteed Maximum Price for Greens Prairie Elementary school

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of the College Station Independent School District approves the purchase of computer equipment, for the amount of \$187,912.00 from Micro Age, for Greens Prairie Elementary School.
