- 3. No disclosures in annual financial report concerning default on bonded indebtedness
- 4. Annual Financial Report filed within one month of deadline (1/28)
- 5.Unqualified "clean" opinion on Annual Financial Report
- 6.No material weaknesses in internal control disclosed in Annual Financial Report
