BACKGROUND

In 2009 the 81st Texas Legislature passed House Bill 3 which gave the outline for a new state accountability system in Texas. Since that time, the Texas Education Agency has been working with representatives from across the state to make recommendations for the new system. Part of the transition plan for the new accountability system included no ratings being released for 2012.

The 2013 state accountability system will not be finalized and announced until April 2013. House Bill 3 mandates several aspects of the new accountability system; however, the legislation does leave a great deal of discretion to the Commissioner of Education.


This presentation will outline the aspects of the new system that are mandated by the legislation and show the various options available to the commissioner for his or her ultimate decision.
