Background

The 2013 Bond program includes purchase of new technology to be utilized throughout the district. This bond program element is the purchase of new servers at twelve campuses, creating new capabilities in the areas of network and file security upgrades. These servers are available from the Department of Information Resources (DIR) contract which meets all requirements of state purchasing law and local policy. The HP ProLiant servers have been determined to be the best value for the district.

Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing, and David Hutchison, Director of Technology, recommend that the HP ProLiant servers be purchased from Avinext according the terms of the state DIR contract #SDD-1364.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of the College Station Independent School District approve the purchase of twelve (12) HP ProLiant servers from Avinext for \$53,733.84 from 2013 bond funds.
