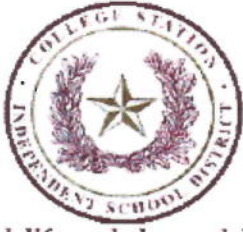

Re: TEA Expedited Waiver for Staff Development (2014-17)

Background

The Texas Education Agency requires that school districts operate for 187 days each school year. Of the 187 days, a minimum of seven days must be used as staff development days. Through a TEA Staff Development Waiver, districts may substitute three staff development days for student days if the district has the need to provide staff development.

CSISD has operated under a TEA Staff Development Waiver for the many years, and we continue to have the need to provide ongoing and sustained staff development beyond the seven days that the State has designated. If approved by the Board, the three additional staff development days requested from the State will be used by CSISD staff members to align our curriculum and assessments horizontally and vertically among grade levels and subject areas, to gain knowledge and develop trainings related to new TEKS and State mandated assessments, and to provide training related to best instructional practices.

The TEA Expedited Waiver for Staff Development is requested for the years 2014-2015, 2015-2016, and 2016-2017.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the College Station Board of Trustees approve the submission of the TEA Expedited Waiver for Staff Development (2014-2017) as presented.
