Background

Edgenuity is a software program designed for many instructional purposes. Timber Academy has been using this program during this school year and is reporting recurring student academic successes. This purchase would expand student program choice to A&M Consolidated High School, College Station High School and High School Summer School. It allows unlimited access to high school course work for original credit, credit recovery, and special education support. Also included in this purchase are STAAR, EOC, SAT, ACT and college exam preparatory courses.

The purchase meets the sole source requirements of state purchasing law as denoted by the attached letter. The Department of Curriculum and Instruction recommends the purchase of this product to create more choice, flexibility and support for our student educational opportunities.
