## BACKGROUND

As part of the 2013 bond program, Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP) for Paging Intercom Bell and Clock systems at fourteen campuses was advertised according to state law and local policy. This RFCSP was mailed directly to fourteen vendors. Four vendors responded and their proposals were evaluated by staff from the Purchasing and Technology Departments as displayed on the attached matrix score sheet.

Firetron, Inc. received the highest score on the matrix, and the district is recommending the option to contract separately for cabling. This proposal presents the best option for the district and is recommended by Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing and David Hutchison, Director of Technology.

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of College Station Independent School District award the Paging Intercom Bell and Clock equipment proposal for fourteen campuses to Firetron, Inc., for a total purchase not to exceed \$1,385,772.61, to be paid from 2013 bond program funds.
