BACKGROUND

Inspired by its work with the Texas High Performance Schools Consortium, College Station ISD has constructed a meaningful accountability system which measures what the College Station community believes is important.

Using the CSISD Core Beliefs and Commitments developed by the Board of Trustees, CSISD developed an accountability system that ranks the district and individual campuses using a variety of indicators. As a part of <u>House Bill 5</u>, each school district is now required to develop a system to evaluate itself and each of its campuses in the following areas:

- Fine arts
- Wellness and PE
- Community and parent involvement
- 21st century workforce development
- Second language acquisition
- Digital learning environment
- Dropout prevention strategies
- Gifted and talented programs
- Reporting and policy requirements

Under the new system, three CSISD campuses earned an exemplary rating, while 12 campuses, along with the district, earned a recognized rating.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the board receive a report summarizing the results on the 2014 Community Based Accountability System.
