Item #1: Entech to remove, replace, existing Hot Water heater with (2) new Lochinvar heaters.

Item #2: Entech to remove, replace, existing boilers B1,B2 and associated mechanical electrical as defined on KME drawings MEP1.01 and MEP2.01 dated 3-18-15.

<u>Item #1 Scope of Work Domestic Hot Water Heater Replacements per EMA but with smaller tank and mixing valve:</u>

- Entech to provide (2) Lochinvar AWN601PM, 600MBTUH 97% efficient Boilers (Currently In Nashville In Stock)
- Entech to provide (1) DMV1 Armstrong mixing valve
- Entech to provide (1) Lochnivar RGA0752 Storage Tank (2 weeks out from Nashville)
- Entech to extend house keeping pad
- Entech to provide new piping, insulation, and labels
- Entech to provide new circulation pumps
- Entech will not provide controls as the boiler will come with controls
- Entech will provide new gas regulator
- Entech will provide Training and documentation

Item #2 SCOPE of WORK:

- Entech to provide (1) B-1 CONDENSING BOILER Patterson-Kelley Company, Mach, gas fired, force draft, condensing, cast aluminum hot water boiler, Model No. C-2000, 2,000,000 BTUH input, 1,920,000 BTUH output, or 96% certified efficiency. (Currently 3-5 weeks lead time ARO)
- Entech to provide (1) B-2 NON-CONDENSING BOILER Patterson-Kelley Company, Modu-Fire FD, gas fired, forced draft, non-condensing, hot water boiler, Model No. N2000-MFD, 2,000,000 BTUH input, 1,700,000 BTUH output, or 85% AGA certified efficiency.
- Entech to provide electrical revisions Note: on base bid, keep starters on HWP1/2.
- ALT# 1 Entech to remove starters and tie in VFD's to be controlled by DPT sensor (provided by others)
- Entech to remove and replace ceiling if necessary including all rigging to set equipment.
- Entech to provide new piping, insulation, and labels.
- Entech to provide new circulation pumps for boilers and keep HWP 1/2 on base bid
- Alt#1 Entech to provide new HWP 1/2 to be controlled by VFD's.
- Entech will not provide controls as the boiler will come with controls and they will tie in to TEAM existing EMS.
- Entech will provide new gas regulator
- Entech will provide Training and documentation
