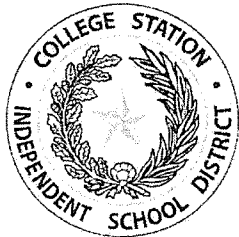

ORDINANCE SETTING TAX RATE

Date: August 16, 2016

On this date, we, the Board of Trustees of the College Station Independent School District, College Station, Texas, hereby levy or set the tax rate on \$100 valuation for the District for the tax year 2016 at a total tax rate of \$ 1.396000, to be assessed and collected by the duly specified assessor and collector as follows:

\$ 1.040000 for the purpose of maintenance and operation, and

\$ 0.356000 for the purpose of payment of principal and interest on debts.

Such taxes are to be assessed and collected by the tax officials designated by the District.

Please be advised that a signed Option 3 **Agreement for the Purchase of Attendance Credits** must be received by September 1, 2016, in order for the district to qualify for the early agreement credit.

The district may proceed with its tax rate adoption process.
