for the 2020-2021 School Year

BACKGROUND

The CSISD District Educational Improvement Council (DEIC) has the responsibility of recommending to the School Board the District Improvement Plan Goals and Objectives each year. The DEIC met on February 12, 2020 and March 4, 2020, to review data regarding achievement of the current District Improvement Plan Goals and to work on the new District Improvement Plan for the 2020-2021 school year. Based on program and assessment data, as well as input from the DEIC, the committee updated objectives and reviewed goals to ensure the current needs of the district were reflected in the new plan. Groups began sharing their input at the March DEIC meeting on specific action steps for the goals and objectives and were scheduled to finish sharing group input at the April meeting. Due to school Sheltering in Place guidelines, all group input was put into the draft DIP for 2020-2021 and the draft was sent out on April 3, 2020 for DEIC members to review. An electronic vote on recommending the plan to the Board of Trustees at the April 21st Regular Board Meeting was taken with final input being due by April 8, 2020. Members voted unanimously (24 to 0) to recommend the plan forward for Board approval. Based on this vote, we would like to recommend the approval of the noted goals and objectives by the School Board for the 2020-2021 school year.

Goals and Objectives

1. Recruit, develop, and retain qualified and dedicated teachers and staff.
2. Provide a challenging, relevant, engaging and aligned curriculum.
3. Provide an array of services, programs and opportunities to meet the needs of each student, and provide the opportunity for each student to reach his or her full potential.
4. Create classroom and campus cultures that involve each family.
5. Commit to the responsible use of taxpayer resources.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the CSISD Board of Trustees approve the District Improvement Plan goals for the 2020-2021 school year.
