BACKGROUND

The purpose of this interlocal agreement is to work collaboratively with the City of College Station to assign School Resource Officers (SRO's) to work with and aid the administration and student bodies of A&M Consolidated High School, College Station High School, A&M Consolidated Middle School, College Station Middle School and the Center for Alternative Learning

The goal for all SRO's is to offer primary services as mentors and problem-solvers, and work to reduce crime through education and the promotion of positive police/student relations.

In this agreement, the number of officers is increased from three to four, and the some of the school placements are modified as well. CSISD will pay 75% and College Station Police Department will pay 25% of the School Resource Officer salary and benefits. The entities will also split the cost of a police cruiser to be used by the additional SRO and the start-up equipment costs for the additional officer on the same 75/25 split.

College Station Police Department has provided officers in College Station Schools since 1994. This new agreement is for a term of three years.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended the CSISD Board of Trustees approve the School Resource Officer Interlocal Agreement as presented.
