

Driver Education (2015-2016)

Description

The Region 6 Education Service Center offers all phases of driver education on-site and through an online classroom for high school students through the following options. Your district's scheduled option is located under "Fee Heading".

OPTION #1

Semester Credit Classroom Phase 1 and Simulation & In-Car Phase 2: Fee: \$390.00 per student

Option 1 consists of 56 hours of Classroom Instruction, 12 hours of Simulation Instruction, 4 hours of Behind-The-Wheel Instruction and 4 hours of In-Car Observation. Option 1 is taught during the school day and students may receive 1/2 elective credit. The Drug and Alcohol Driving Awareness Program (DADAP) can be added to the classroom instruction for an additional 5% insurance reduction.

OPTION #2

Non School Credit Classroom Phase 1 and Simulation & In-Car Phase 2: Fee: \$390.00 per student

Option 2 consists of 32 hours of Classroom Instruction, 12 hours of Simulation Instruction, 4 hours of Behind-The-Wheel Instruction and 4 hours of In-Car Observation. Option 2 can be taught after school and/or during the summer. The Drug and Alcohol Driving Awareness Program (DADAP) can be added to the classroom instruction for an additional 5% insurance reduction.

OPTION #3

Simulation & In-Car Phase 2: Fee: \$330.00 per student

Option 3 Laboratory Phase 2 consists of 12 hours of Simulation Instruction, 4 hours Behind-The-Wheel Instruction and 4 hours of In-Car Observation. Students must be at least 15 years old with a beginner's permit to complete the Behind-The-Wheel phase. (Classroom Phase 1 conducted by the District) Option 3 can be taught during the school day, and/or after school and/or during the summer.

OPTION #4

Simulation Phase 2: Fee: \$100.00 per student

Option 4 consists of 12 hours of Simulation Instruction. The 12 hours of simulation instruction reduces 7

hours of Behind-The-Wheel to 4 hours Behind-The-Wheel. (Classroom and the In-Car Phase conducted by the District) Option 4 can be taught during the school day, and/or after school and/or during the summer.

OPTION #5

Non School Credit Classroom Phase 1: Fee: \$175.00 per student

Option 5 consists of 32 hours of Classroom Instruction Only. Option 5 can be taught after school or during the summer. The Drug and Alcohol Driving Awareness Program (DADAP) can be added to the classroom instruction for an additional 5% insurance reduction. After completion of the classroom hours, the student's classroom hours will be transferred to complete the **Laboratory Phase 2** (In-Car driving portion) through the following; **School District - Private Driving School - DPS Parent Taught Program** - The Parent Taught Course 106 Curriculum will be provided for the completion of the Behind-The-Wheel phase through DPS Parent Taught Program at a discounted fee of \$50.

OPTION #6

"Online" Non School Credit Classroom Phase 1: Fee: \$100.00 per student

Option 6 consists of 32 hours of Online Classroom Instruction.

After completion of the classroom hours, the student's classroom hours will be transferred to complete the **Laboratory Phase 2** (In-Car driving portion) through the following; **School District - Private Driving School - DPS Parent Taught Program** - The Parent Taught Course 106 Curriculum will be provided for the completion of the Behind-The-Wheel phase through DPS Parent Taught Program at a discounted fee of \$50.

Students must be at least 15 years old to obtain a learners permit for the Phase 2 Behind-The-Wheel and be enrolled in a public or private school and have attended school for at least 80 days in the fall or spring semester preceding the first day of class; or students must be enrolled for at least 45 days and currently enrolled in a program to prepare persons to pass the high school equivalency exam (GED).






