and it was great to see quite a few kids from CSISD. Upcoming Events Superintendent Upcoming events • This morning, the BCS Chamber adopted a resolution against A-F accountability system. We appreciate their stepping up joining over 500 school districts in the State and Angelina County in supporting the students in our community and the State. Legislature highlights: the appropriations bills are moving through the Senate and the House and at this point there is a significant difference between the two versions. There is a \$1.74 billion difference in education alone and that has to do with the money available to lessen the effect of recapture. The passing of HB 21 would be very advantageous for CSISD in the form of additional funding. Regarding A-F, some very close bills have been filed – HB 22 and SB 2051. Both look to lessen the 5 domains down to 3 and get rid of some of the troubling issues they have right now with Domain 3 and Domain 4. Both would continue to keep A-F ratings for schools and school districts. All of these bear watching over the next few months.
