BACKGROUND

College Station Independent School District recently entered into an agreement with Brazos County to supply five (5) School Resource Deputies (SRD) for the three high schools and the two middle schools beginning with the 2017-2018 school year. Included in this agreement is the purchase of five (5) law enforcement vehicles and related equipment by the district. The purchase of these vehicles was approved at the March board meeting for a cost of \$115,525.00.


Most of the remaining equipment, technology and other services requested by Brazos County to outfit the vehicles are available through contracts with the Department of Information Resources (DIR), BuyBoard Cooperative, Houston-Galveston Area Council Cooperative, and Brazos County. Contracts for these agencies and cooperatives have been competitively bid and meet the competitive bid requirements stipulated in Texas Government Code, Section 791.025.

The requested items for purchase to outfit the five (5) School Resource Deputy vehicles are itemized in the provided memo by Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing, and totals \$127,113.62.

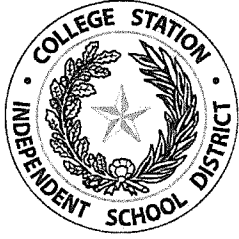
