BACKGROUND

The consideration of new courses at the high school level is the result of input focused upon meeting student needs and interests.

As in the past, Board approval allows the district the opportunity to offer the courses to see how many students are interested in signing-up for them; whether a course 'makes' is dependent upon such variables as student enrollment, teacher certification, and teacher availability.

The high school courses (attached) were unanimously approved by the campus School Improvement Planning team and the District Educational Improvement Council.

It is recommended the College Station Board of Trustees approve the new high school courses beginning with the 2017-18 school year as presented.
