Subject: Consideration and possible action on the approval of an Interlocal Agreement with Brazos County, Texas concerning the School Resource Deputy program.

## BACKGROUND

In July of 2016, when meeting to negotiate a new School Resource Officer (SRO) Interlocal Agreement (ILA), College Station Police Department notified CSISD that they intended to phase out of the SRO arrangement and would provide a one year transition period for CSISD to develop another program.

This started a process whereby the school district carefully considered the feasibility of all available options and discussed these possibilities with local law enforcement officials.

Ultimately, the Brazos County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) was determined to be the best option for providing CSISD with School Resource Deputies to fill this critical safety and security role for the school district.

As per the Brazos County Sheriff's Office proposal, the attached Interlocal Agreement would initially include providing five School Resource Deputies to cover the three high schools and the two middle schools, and would have a term length of five years. The school district would pay for 100% of the salary and benefits for these School Resource Deputies as well as purchase and own the vehicles and equipment necessary for their work.

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of College Station Independent School District approve the RESOLUTION to execute the attached School Resource Deputy Interlocal Agreement between Brazos County and the College Station Independent School District.
