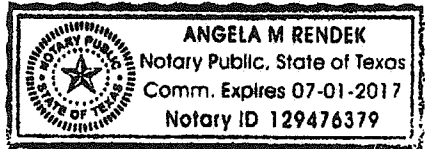

ADDENDUM "A"

The Vendor has had no business relationship with the government officer described in paragraph 3 above in the last 12 months that exceeded \$2,500.00 in fees. The Vendor does have a business relationship with the Ellison Firm, a business in which the officer is a partner. The Vendor has no information about how fees paid to the Ellison Firm are apportioned and distributed to the partners. If the officer did receive taxable income as a result of this relationship, the Vendor does not know if it exceeded the \$2,500.00 threshold established in Local Government Code §176.003 (a)(2)(A). In the interest of full disclosure, the Vendor has used the Ellison Firm, primarily for real estate transactions, in the last 12 months the fees for which have exceeded the above stated threshold amount.
