BACKGROUND

As a part of the 2015 bond program, the Technology Department has identified audio-visual equipment required for Pecan Trail Intermediate School. The district has worked with Avinext to secure the attached quote (#171488) for SMART Interactive displays, associated mounting hardware, and cabling.

These audio-visual components are available from Avinext through the Texas A&M University Multimedia Contract AM02-16-PO16040. All items in this agreement have been competitively bid and meet competitive bid requirements outlined in Texas Government Code, Section 791.025.

Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing, and David Hutchison, Director of Technology, recommend that we purchase the audio-visual equipment for Pecan Trail Intermediate from Avinext for the cost of \$249,659.58 per Texas A&M University Multimedia Contract AM02-16-PO16040 using 2015 Bond Funds.
