BACKGROUND

As part of the 2015 Bond program, a list of library books needed for the opening of Pecan Trail Intermediate School was developed. Quotes for this comprehensive list developed by the Librarian at A&M Consolidate High School were requested from Bound to Stay Bound Books, Mackin Educational Resources, Follet School Solutions, Davis Titles, ABDO Publishing, and Capstone.

The quote provided by Bound to Stay Bound Books was determined to be the most comprehensive and most fitted the needs of the district. The books selected are available through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (BuyBoard) in which College Station ISD is a member.

It is the recommendation of Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing, and Kellie Deegear, Principal of Pecan Trail Intermediate School, to purchase the library books for Pecan Trail Intermediate from Bound to Stay Bound Books for a total of \$154,688.20 per BuyBoard Contract #531-17 to be paid from 2015 Bond Funds.
