BACKGROUND

As part of the 2015 Bond Program, the Technology Department has identified the need for audio enhancement systems for teachers at Rock Prairie Elementary and Southwood Valley Elementary Schools.

From the three submitted bids, M&A Technology, an approved vendor of The Purchasing Cooperative Network (TCPN), provided the lowest.

It is the recommendation of Mark Pantel, Director of Purchasing, and David Hutchison, Director of Technology, to purchase the Classroom Audio Enhancement Systems for teachers at Rock Prairie Elementary and Southwood Valley Elementary from M&A Technology for \$75,446.73 per TCPN contract #R5111 to be paid for from the 2015 Bond funds.
