



## BACKGROUND

The proposed policy FFAC (Local) authorizes CSISD school personnel who have been adequately trained to administer an epinephrine auto-injector in accordance with law and this policy. Administration of epinephrine shall only be permitted when an authorized and trained individual reasonably believes a person is experiencing anaphylaxis.

The District shall ensure that at each campus a sufficient number of personnel are trained to administer epinephrine so that at least one trained individual is present on campus during all hours the campus is open. For purposes of this policy, the campus shall be considered open beginning with the first hour of instruction through the last hour of instruction.

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended the CSISD Board of Trustees approve policy FFAC (Local) as presented.
