the work associated with the construction of the New Server Room project.

BACKGROUND

In November 2013, College Station ISD voters passed a bond issue for \$83.5 million for construction and renovation to district facilities. One of the major projects identified from this bond package was the Renovate and Repurpose Warehouse and Current Purchasing Building project. This agenda item represents the work related to preparing the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) and total project budget for the first phase of that work, namely the New Server Room project.

The GMP for the New Server Room project was based on Requests for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP). The RFCSP have been advertised to the public as required by statute. The Construction Manager at Risk, Pepper Lawson Construction, coordinated the competitive sealed proposal process for this work. Theo Rouse, CSISD Coordinator of Construction Services was present as the proposals were received and tabulated on September 6, 2016.

In consultation with CSISD and VLK Architects, Pepper Lawson Construction has reviewed the final scope of work, reputation of sub-contractors, quality of materials specified, and other relevant factors in arriving at the GMP for the project. Pepper Lawson Construction proposes a GMP for the project in the amount of \$1,481,253. This would leave \$4,665,747 for the Warehouse Renovation phase of this work, which will be bidding in November 2016.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of College Station Independent School District consider approval of the Guaranteed Maximum Price of \$1,481,253 from Pepper Lawson Construction and the total project budget in the amount of \$1,834,253 for the New Server Room project. It is further recommended that the Superintendent or his designee be authorized to sign any necessary documents to implement the Guaranteed Maximum Price and that the Board of Trustees authorizes the commencement of the work associated with this project.
