BACKGROUND

As part of the 2015 Bond, a list of library books needed for the opening of Wellborn Middle School was developed by the librarian at Pecan Trail Intermediate School. As a part of this process, a quote from Mackin Educational Resources was requested.

The opening day collection quote provided by Mackin Educational Resources was determined to be the most comprehensive due to their wide selection of titles in stock with detailed collection development, shelf-ready processing and labeling, a guaranteed delivery of July, and a lifetime guarantee on the books. The books selected are available through the Texas Local Government Purchasing Cooperative (BuyBoard) in which College Station ISD is a member.
