## ORDINANCE SETTING TAX RATE

Date: August 15, 2017

On this date, we, the Board of Trustees of the College Station Independent School District, College Station, Texas, hereby levy or set the tax rate on \$100 valuation for the District for the tax year 2017 at a total tax rate of \$ 1.398000, to be assessed and collected by the duly specified assessor and collector as follows:

\$ 1.040000 for the purpose of maintenance and operation, and

\$ 0.358000 for the purpose of payment of principal and interest on debts.

Such taxes are to be assessed and collected by the tax officials designated by the District.
