Subject: Resolution Identifying Hazardous Traffic Conditions - Transportation

BACKGROUND

As per Board Policy CNA (LOCAL), the Board shall annually adopt a resolution to identify hazardous traffic conditions within two miles of a school campus. The resolution shall describe the specific hazardous areas in which students reside who would otherwise be ineligible for transportation, but for whom the District shall provide transportation because of the hazardous traffic conditions in those areas.

The maps attached to this agenda item contain the campus served, hazardous roads, areas affected and bus numbers that serve each particular area. The hazardous traffic conditions areas identified for 2017-18 remain consistent with those identified in the 2016-17 school year.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the College Station Independent School District Board of Trustees approve the attached resolution regarding hazardous traffic conditions for the 2017-18 school year.
