#### **BACKGROUND**

In November 2013, College Station ISD voters passed a bond issue for \$83.5 million for construction and renovation to district facilities. One of the major projects identified from this bond package was the Renovate and Repurpose the Current Warehouse and Purchasing Building project. The three phases of that work have now been completed, and an additional project has been identified that would improve the function of the Central Office area by creating a corridor through the front section of the building for access to the new back section of the building. This agenda item represents the work related to preparing the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) and total project budget for this renovation project. This project would be funded with 2013 Bond funds.

The GMP for the Central Office Modification project was based on Requests for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP). The RFCSP have been advertised to the public as required by statute. The Construction Manager at Risk, Pepper Lawson Construction, coordinated the competitive sealed proposal process for this work. Theo Rouse, CSISD Coordinator of Construction Services and Tom Stewart, Construction Inspector, were present as the proposals were received and tabulated on December 7, 2017.

In consultation with CSISD and VLK Architects, Pepper Lawson Construction has reviewed the final scope of work, reputation of sub-contractors, quality of materials specified, and other relevant factors in arriving at the GMP for the project. Pepper Lawson Construction proposes a GMP for the project in the amount of \$127,353.
