BACKGROUND

With board approval, College Station ISD may submit a waiver to the Texas Education Agency for Modified Schedule for State Assessment Days. This waiver allows the district to modify the schedule of classes for students who are not being tested to report to and attend school after the state assessment testing period has ended, therefore reducing the interruptions during testing period.

Students who are not being tested must still meet the maximum 2-through 4-hour requirement for funding (see SAAH 3.6.6 Attendance Accounting during Testing Days). The waiver will allow the district to take official attendance at an alternative time instead of the normal official attendance time.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the board approve submission of the Modified Schedule for State Assessment Days waiver to the Texas Education Agency for the 2017-18, 2018-19, and 2019-2020 school years.
