Subject: Report on School Board Continuing Education

BACKGROUND

Since 1986, the State Board of Education rule has required that a public announcement be made each year of the names of the board members who have completed the required continuing education hours and who are deficient. The annual required continuing education is a basic obligation and expectation of any sitting board member under State Board of Education rule. The president shall cause the minutes of the local board to reflect the information.

Senate Bill 1566 passed in the 85th Legislative Session amended the TEC section 11.159, section (b) changed the reporting board training hours from the last regular meeting of the calendar year to the meeting held before an election of trustees.

The minutes must now reflect whether each trustee has met or is deficient in meeting the training required for the trustee as of the first anniversary of the date of the trustee's election or appointment.

All seven of the College Station ISD trustees have met the required training as of the first anniversary of their election to the College Station ISD Board of Trustees.
