## **BACKGROUND**

On Monday, August 28, 2017, College Station ISD closed because of Hurricane Harvey. Due to the massive devastation along the Gulf Coast of Texas, the Texas Education Agency (TEA) provided districts the option to request a waiver to not make up missed days due to the Hurricane Harvey. College Station ISD received approval from the board of trustees to submit the appropriate waiver to TEA to not make up the district's missed day of Monday, August 28, 2017, at the September 19, 2017 board meeting.

According to Policy DEA (LOCAL), the board, by resolution or other action, shall approve payment for all employees during an emergency closing for which workdays are not scheduled to be made up.

## RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the College Station ISD Board of Trustees approve the attached resolution to pay all employees for the missed work day due to the closure of the district on Monday, August 28, 2017 due to Hurricane Harvey.
