BACKGROUND

The current state accountability system rates each district and campus to indicate acceptable and unacceptable performance using the labels *Met Standard* or *Improvement Required*. In August 2017, College View High School was assigned a rating of *Improvement Required* due to state test results on Index 3, which measures the performance of Economically Disadvantaged students on English I and English II End-of-Course STAAR exams.

As a result, College View High School will engage in the Texas Accountability Intervention System (TAIS) process to identify the root cause(s) of performance issues and implement a plan for improvement. As an initial step in this process, the College View High School Improvement Team met to revise the 2017-18 Campus Improvement Plan and identify targeted elements of the plan. Upon approval, these targeted elements will be areas of focus throughout this school year and support improvement of student outcomes in the areas of Reading and Mathematics.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the board approve the targeted elements of the College View High School Improvement Plan for the 2017-18 school year.
