BACKGROUND

Head Start Program Performance Standards require the development of a triennial Community Assessment for each program to use in planning and determining needs in the local area. Information is gathered from a wide variety of local organizations and entities to show a true picture of the needs and strengths of the district and the surrounding area. The analysis of this data is done by program administration and results in furthering planning to increase quality and improve outcomes overall for children and families.
