Subject: TEA Missed School Day Waiver

BACKGROUND

Commissioner Mike Morath released a letter on August 29, 2017 for the 58-county disaster declaration area created by Hurricane Harvey. This letter allows districts in the designated 58 counties to pursue a waiver for missed days of school due to the hurricane. If granted this waiver, the state would waive the 420 minutes of missed instructional time College Station ISD students missed on August 28, 2017 without any penalty to funding. College Station ISD would still meet the state mandated minutes of 75,600 operational minutes if granted this waiver.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the board approve the request for a waiver for the missed instructional day of school on August 28, 2017 because of Hurricane Harvey. Upon approval of the Board, College Station ISD will submit the waiver request to the Texas Education Agency.
