Subject: Consider approval of School District Teaching Permits for Athletic Trainers

BACKGROUND

The Texas Education Agency has recently allowed Texas school districts to employ teachers in CTE non-academic core credit areas who do not possess teacher certification. To employ such persons in this capacity requires approval by Texas school boards.

Currently, College Station High School and A&M Consolidated High School wish to schedule two licensed athletic trainers into roles of teaching sports medicine courses and one course in athletic training for state elective credit.

After the Board considers and possibly approves the permit, the College Station ISD Human Resources Department will provide TEA notification of this approval.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended the College Station ISD Board of Trustees approve non-core area School District Teaching Permits as recommended.
