## **BACKGROUND**

The Director of the College Station ISD Birth to Five Head Start Program was notified by the Regional Office that there is additional Health and Safety Federal Grant Funds available to programs who wish to apply to be considered for the additional grant funds. This request must be accompanied by the approval of the Birth to Five Head Start Program Policy Council and the CSISD Board of Trustees. The Policy Council conducted an electronic vote following the April 9, 2019 meeting, and the motion to apply for additional health and safety grant funds passed unanimously. If allowed to apply for the funds, the CSISD Birth to Five Head Start Program will be requesting resurfacing playgrounds at Creek View, Southwood Valley, and College Hills. It would also include replacing an old wooden structure on the College Hills Elementary playground.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the CSISD Board of Trustees approve the request to apply for the Birth to Five Head Start Health and Safety additional funding for the purpose of resurfacing Head Start playgrounds at Creek View, Southwood Valley, and College Hills, and a wooden structure on the College Hills Elementary playground.
