Background

College Station ISD strives to afford all learners real world, challenging, authentic experiences that develop their creativity, confidence, and competence in a safe and healthy learning environment that celebrates diversity through meaningful relationships.

To help foster learners' development in the educational environment, a committee was developed to review past long range technology plans, discuss lessons learned and develop goals and strategies to guide future technology endeavors. The Long Range Technology Planning committee included 30 members and was comprised of teachers, administrators and technology staff.

The 2019-2024 Long Range Technology Plan builds upon past progress, with a renewed emphasis on staff development, community involvement and access to digital resources.

As a result of the committee's hard work, the following goals were developed:

- Teaching and Learning: Enhance the teaching and learning process through purposeful integration of relevant digital resources across all learning environments.
- 2. Professional Development and Communication: Equip CSISD stakeholders with the knowledge, skills, and strategies to purposefully integrate Instructional technology into learning experiences and to effectively communicate with the CSISD community.
- 3. Technology Ecosystems: Develop a flexible technology ecosystem that promotes digital learning and operational efficiency.
