ADMISSIONS INTERDISTRICT TRANSFERS FDA (LOCAL)

PROPOSED REVISIONS

No Interdistrict Transfers A nonresident student shall not be permitted to attend District schools except as provided below.

Exceptions

A resident student who becomes a nonresident any time during the school year shall be permitted to continue in attendance for the remainder of the grading period in which the student becomes a nonresident.

A nonresident full-time District employee may request that his or her child be admitted into District schools by filing an application with the Superintendent or designee. To be considered full time, an employee shall work a minimum of 30 hours weekly. Transfers shall be granted for one regular school year at a time, on a tuitionfree basis.

A nonresident student wishing to transfer into the District to participate in the District's fire science career and technical education program shall file an application for transfer each school year with the Superintendent. Transfers shall be granted for one regular school year at a time.

Assignment

The District reserves the right to place or change placement of a nonresident transfer student who is the child of a full-time employee as necessary to balance enrollment or adjust feeder patterns as needed.

Factors

In approving transfers, the Superintendent or designee shall consider availability of space and instructional staff and the student's disciplinary history and attendance records.

Transfer Agreements A transfer student shall be notified in the written transfer agreement that he or she must follow all rules and regulations of the District. Violation of the terms of the agreement may result in a transfer request not being approved the following year.

Tuition

If the District charges tuition, the amount shall be set by the Board, within statutory limits.

Waivers

The Board may waive tuition for a student based on financial hard ship upon written application by the student, parent, or guardian.

Nonpayment

The District may initiate withdrawal of students whose tuition payments are delinquent.

No Transportation

Transportation shall not be provided for any nonresident student who attends District schools.
