BACKGROUND

The Career and Technology Education (CTE) department, in consultation with the technology department, have identified the need to purchase updated computers for CTE classrooms at A&M Consolidated High School and College Station High School. The district secured three quotes for the needed computers.

Avinext provided the lowest quote per the Education Service Center (ESC) Region 6 Educational Purchasing Interlocal Cooperative (EPIC6) Contract 22.18. EPIC6 contracts have been competitively bid and meet competitive bid requirements.

Carmella Shafer, Director of Purchasing, and David Hutchison, Director of Technology, recommend the purchase of computers for CTE classrooms at A&M Consolidated High School and College Station High School from Avinext in the amount of \$102,500.00 per EPIC6 Contract 22.18 using Perkins Federal Grant Funds.
