BACKGROUND

At the March 9, 2021 College Station ISD School Board Workshop, Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) Policy Update 116 was presented for discussion. This update provides legal and policy updates as recommended by TASB.

TASB Update 116 includes recommended (LOCAL) policy revisions concerning the dismissal appeal process for employees, cybersecurity training, student medical treatment, and community conduct on school premises. While not covered in this publication, many of the (LEGAL) policies included in this update were affected by recent changes to Administrative Code rules or legislation from the 86th Legislative Session that will be effective as of January 1, 2021.

Legal policy updates are governed by current law or court rulings; therefore, College Station ISD must include them in school board policy by statute. Local policy updates are designated to provide clarification on legal policies and provide appropriate discretion as decisions are made regarding the school district. Local policies in this update include the following:

- CQB(LOCAL): Technology Resources – Cybersecurity
- DCD(LOCAL): Employment Practices – At-Will Employment
- FFAC(LOCAL): Wellness and Health Services – Medical Treatment
- GKA(LOCAL): Community Relations – Conduct on School Premises

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the College Station ISD Board of Trustees approve TASB Policy Update 116 as presented.
