BACKGROUND

Public school districts are required to certify annually to the State Board of Education and the Commissioner that for each subject in the required curriculum students have access to the instructional materials that cover all the TEKS. The district requests school board certification before ordering 2021-2022 instructional materials from the Instructional Materials Allotment. These purchased materials will comply with the TEKS requirements under state law.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the College Station Independent School District Board of Trustees certify that the district complies with Texas Education Code regarding the Instructional Materials Allotment and TEKS Certification for the 2021-2022 school year.
