BACKGROUND

College Station ISD recently experienced inclement weather conditions of snow, rain and freezing rain, and in its aftermath dangerous road conditions and closures resulted, as well as power outages and rolling blackouts. These infrastructure issues related to outages prevented the district from providing remote instruction to students. Due to the conditions stated above, for the safety of students and staff, schools, and facilities within CSISD were closed for four instructional days beginning on Tuesday, February 16, 2021 through Friday February 19, 2021.

For school closure based on recent weather related concerns during this time, each Local Education Agency (LEA) must seek additional minute waivers from the Texas Education Agency to meet the 75,600 operational minute requirement. Per guidance from the Texas Education Agency, all missed school days will continue to be designated as instructional days in the district's attendance accounting software.

The District Educational Improvement Council (DEIC) participated in an electronic vote, and by majority rule they approved the submission of this waiver prior to board action.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the College Station ISD Board of Trustees approve College Station ISD's submission of the Missed Instructional Days Waiver for February 16-19, 2021 to the Texas Education Agency.
