Background

Each year, CSISD adopts a Student Code of Conduct that provides students and families a framework of policies and practices used by the district to maintain its focus on helping students be academically, socially, and behaviorally successful. The Student Code of Conduct clearly states the behavioral expectations for students, the due process procedures, and the consequences for students who do not meet behavioral expectations.

The CSISD Student Code of Conduct is available to the student and parents through the CSISD web site and hard copies for interested individuals will be made available. Additionally, the document is published in Spanish.

The 2021-22 Student Code of Conduct has been updated using the TASB model to reflect changes from the recent legislative session and ensure continued compliance with Chapter 37 of the Texas Education Code. This document addresses legal compliance and organizes provisions of the law that communicate what is expected of students and how misconduct will be handled. Minimal changes were made for 2021-22 upon the recommendation of TASB to provide clarification in language and alignment with new legislation.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the College Station Independent School District Board of Trustees approve the 2021-22 Student Code of Conduct as presented.
