We are required to administer an assessment to 7th graders who failed their STAAR reading assessment in 6th grade. We would like to have our students use the Measure of Academic Progress (MAP) assessment instead of one of the four assessments approved by the Commissioner.

If this waiver is granted, our 7th grade students who failed their 6th grade STAAR reading assessment would take the MAP assessments with their class and would not be pulled out of class for a different assessment. Teachers and administrators would use the data from student's MAP assessment analyze strengths and weaknesses of students and to then plan targeted instruction and/or tutoring for areas of weakness.

Having a consistent assessment for beginning, middle, & end of the year allows for more valid & reliable data, allowing us to effectively meet student learning needs. MAP is highly aligned to STAAR.
